Flatware is in the fiddle pattern – I have seen a tablespoon and two konfyf forks (or perhaps the same one sold twice).

Snuff boxes have engraved decoration including oval cartouches of leafage, and include both conventional rectangular boxes as well as silver-mounted cowrie shells. Welz illustrated an attractive rectangular box with a simulated clockface, rotating hand and engraved decoration.

The only piece of significance I have seen is a square salver with gadrooned border and band of engraved decoration. A napkin clip also bears his mark.
