

# Jan Lotter

Likely active period:

**1813-1817 and before/after**

Born/baptised : Unknown

Died : Unknown

The majority of the objects I have seen exhibit characteristics of Welz's "Heterogeneous Period (1795-1830)" suggesting that he was not active long before the turn of the 19<sup>th</sup> century.

Table flatware is generally in the Old English pattern. Serving pieces in this pattern include soup- and sauce ladles, mustard spoons and basting spoons.

Konfyf forks are found in both the Old English Pattern and with pointed terminals, sometimes with engraved decoration. Attractive orange spoons with pointed terminals usually have engraved borders or motifs.

I have seen reference to only one snuff box, rectangular with rounded ends and engraved with a cartouche and wrigglework borders.

Other items include beakers, brandy saucepans, sugar bowls, tea caddies and teapots. The English influence is clearly visible in these items, and they are either quite plain or with bands of engraved decoration.

Welz also recorded a large baptismal font, plain with reeded border, in the Dutch Reformed Church George.
